

It is commendable that the Spice Route State Units, AFPI CPD, and AFPI state chapters have adhered to the National Academic schedule to a large extent, and that a sizable number of online academic sessions were held in 2023.

I am pleased to inform you that the new national academic calendar for 2024 has been prepared by considering the following aspects:

- Since the Obstetric-Gynaecology and Paediatric topics were not adequately covered during the past years, it has been decided to conduct an exclusive year-long National Clinical meets on the topics related to OBSTETRICS-GYNAECOLOGY AND PAEDIATRICS: A PRIMARY CARE APPROACH.

 These topics are included in the NAC, and AFPI state chapters will lead these sessions.
- Every month on the last Saturday, AFPI CPD will host sessions on a range of current problems.
- ❖ Every month during the first week, AFPI Spice Route will host webinars for PG case discussions.

All national or international events, including AFPI state conferences, shall be held with the consent of the National Executive body and should have a sufficient break in between. The National Executive should be informed of all other events planned by AFPI units, and a Central registry will maintain the database of all events.

I appeal to all the concerned doctors to adhere to the National Academic Calendar-2024 and conduct the academic sessions accordingly. I am sure that these academic and professional activities would enhance the knowledge, attitudes, and skills of our family physicians and take us forward.
